NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Public Hearing will be held before the Town Board of the Town of Lewiston on the 27th day of December, 2007 beginning at 6:30 p.m. at the Town Hall, 1375 Ridge Road. Lewiston, New York for the purpose of conducting a hearing to consider whether an agreement should be made for the furnishing of fire protection within the Town of Lewiston by the Sanborn Volunteer Fire Company, Upper Mountain Fire Company and Lewiston Fire Company No. 2 respectively, for the years 2208 through 2011 inclusive at a cost to the Town of Lewiston for each of such fire companies as follows:

The Supervisor asked that Atty. Leone give a review of the contracts.

Leone: The contracts are for a 4 year period with increases of \$10,000 per year. There are a couple of changes to the contract, those being that the fire companies had requested that the date for payment be earlier than March 1st and whether the funds would be available and approved by the Town Board. Also, a request to have the physicals that the Town is required to pay for to be in compliance and that has been included in the contract. There was also a request for \$2000 per company annually for the purpose of recruiting additional fire hazard training for firefighters that are already in place. These items have been added. Ransomville has the set fee. With respect to the contract with Pekin Fire. Company, I have spoken with their attorney and we have agreed on the language and I will present it when it is received. Lewiston Fire Co. #1 contract is with the Village of Lewiston and they are a party to the contract and the terms are essentially the same.

James Franey of 414 Harper Drive asked if there would have to be a separate public hearing for the contract with the Village for Lewiston Fire Co. #1.

Leone: No. I neglected to put it in the notice and the contract has been prepared by me and is essentially the same.

**TOWN OF LEWISTON
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Public Hearing will be held before the Town Board of the Town of Lewiston on the 27th day of December, 2007 beginning at 6:45 p.m. at the Lewiston Town Hall on two State mandated stormwater laws. Proposed Local Law No. 3 of 2007 contains the requirements for erosion and sediment control amending Chapter 6C, Control of Drainage; Chapter 8, Disposal of Runoff Waters; Chapter 8D, Excavations; Chapter 10A, Flood Damage Prevention; Chapter 19A, Mobile Homes; Chapter 22A, Subdivision Regulations; and Chapter 30, Zoning; of the Code of the Town of Lewiston, in relation to stormwater management. Proposed Local Law No.4 of 2007 is required to prohibit illicit discharges to the Town's stormwater system amending Chapter 21, Sewers, of the Code of the Town of Lewiston, in relation to the prohibition of illicit discharges, activities and connections to the municipal separate storm sewer system. Copies of the proposed text of the laws are on file in the Town Clerk's office where they may be examined during normal business hours. All persons of interest will be given an opportunity to be heard.
