Dear Supervisor Broderick,

As you know the Niagara River Greenway and NYS Parks have been working with the Town of Lewiston and the Town of Porter for the past year on the Lower Niagara Trail Study (LNTS), which has resulted in the conceptual design of a network of trails connecting all of the communities in the Lower Niagara Region with our regional Shoreline Trail. Now the construction of your waterline replacement project along Lower River Road (18F) from Pletcher to the top of Joe Davis Park provides a timely opportunity to install a demonstration section of an improved sidewalk meeting the specifications of our Greenway Shoreline Trail. This trail section would be connected via the Joe Davis Park road, and the existing trail along Pletcher to the Parkway trail, which then extends all the way south to Mohawk St in the Village of Lewiston.

The Niagara Greenway parent funding organization, Natural Heritage Trust (NHT) is holding a grant from the Wilson Foundation which we requested 2 years ago to be used somewhere in the Lower Niagara Trail Study area to create a connecting section of the Shoreline Trail. Pending your approval, and a copy of the change order, we will provide up to \$250,000 to cover the incremental cost of widening the former sidewalk to an average width of 8 feet, as an expansion of your GHD/Milherst repaving project. Final authorization of this funds transfer will be between Natural Heritage Trust and the Town of Lewiston and needs to occur promptly to meet the construction schedule.

Dickersonville Cemetery, Lewiston NY Rules and Regulations

- 1. All plots in said cemetery are to be for the sole purpose of human burial.
- 2. No interment shall be allowed without a deed first being obtained from the Town Clerk, Town of Lewiston. Cost of said deed, for Town residents shall be three-hundred dollars (\$300) per plot, non-residents four-hundred dollars (\$400) per plot.
- 3. All internments shall be recorded with the Town Clerk of the Town of Lewiston. The record (burial permit) must contain, as required by New York State Health Department Regulations, the following:
 - Name of deceased
 - Age date of birth
 - Place of birth
 - Place of death
 - Date of internment
 - If not an adult, name of parents or legal guardian
- 4. Monies from the sale of such plots shall be kept in a Capital Town Account entitled "Dickersonville Cemetery". Such monies will be used for the sole purpose of maintenance/up-keep of said cemetery by the Town of Lewiston.
- 5. It shall be the responsibility of the plot owner to provide / arrange interment arrangements.
- 6. Person in charge of Dickersonville Cemetery shall be *Director of Parks* (Maintenance Director) or designee named by said *Director* (Maintenance Director). Person in charge shall be responsible for locating grass site as plot is sold to the family of deceased.

The following specific ground rules also apply:

- 1. Plot owners are prohibited from allowing interments to be made in their plots from compensation.
- 2. The full purchase price must be paid to the Town before a deed is transmitted.
- 3. The Town of Lewiston reserves the right to remove all flowers, wreaths, or other decorations from plots as soon as they become unsightly.
- 4. The Town of Lewiston reserves the right to remove, after due notice to the owner, any monument, marker or effigy which, in their opinion, is unsightly or dangerous.
- 5. The Town of Lewiston reserves the right to restrict the planting of shrubs and trees and to remove any shrubs or trees deemed to be dangerous to the public.

Dickersonville Cemetery CEMETERY CONSENT

The Town of Lewiston, by executing the consent for the foundation and headstone, consents only to its location and placement.

The Town will not be responsible for any costs, and will not cause the foundation to be constructed or placed.

Any and all costs must be borne by the individual(s) who contract for the headstone and all coordination for the headstones, foundation, placement, grave digging and interment must be conducted between the monument company, the funeral director and the individuals.
