The Supervisor asked Building Inspector Masters to give a break-down of the proposed Code changes.

Masters said the Town has updated Chapter 30, the Zoning Map, Comprehensive Plan and the Vision map. All were forwarded to General Code. They reviewed the complete Town Code and in the process noted several Chapters that reference 1958 & 1966 standards and the Town should consider updating them.

Chapter 23 – Unsafe Buildings was rewritten to the new Chapter 30. It is not being removed, but placed into the appropriate Chapters.

Chapter 29 – Zoning Enforcement also rewritten into the new Code, therefore removing the old language.

Chapter 6 – Building Code is one paragraph stating the code was adopted in 1963. This was added to Chapter 30.

Chapter 7 – Discarded Refrigerators is enforced by current Penal Code, therefore it was suggested this be removed.

There are approximately 8 other chapters that need to be reviewed by Attorney Davis and the Department Heads that they affect. The Code will be updated again when this step is complete.

Supervisor asked if any resident wished to address the Board on this issue. No resident spoke.

The Supervisor asked Attorney Davis his thoughts on this issue. Davis said these are really just organizational or house-cleaning actions.

Bax MOVED to close the Public Hearing for the Modification of the Town Code, Seconded by Winkley and Carried 5 – 0.
