Dickersonville Cemetery, Lewiston NY Rules and Regulations

- 1. All plots in said cemetery are to be for the sole purpose of human burial.
- 2. No interment shall be allowed without a deed first being obtained from the Town Clerk, of the Town of Lewiston. Cost of said deed, for Town residents shall be three-hundred dollars (\$300) per plot, non-residents four-hundred dollars (\$400) per plot.
- 3. All internments shall be recorded with the Town Clerk of the Town of Lewiston. The record (burial permit) must show contain, as required by New York State Health Department Regulations, the following:
 - Name of deceased
 - Age date of birth
 - Place of birth
 - Place of death
 - Date of internment
 - If not an adult, name of parents or legal guardian
- 4. Monies from the sale of such plots shall be kept in a special Capital Town Account entitled "Dickersonville Cemetery". Such monies will be used for the sole purpose of maintenance/up-keep of said cemetery by the Town of Lewiston.
- 5. It shall be the responsibility of the plot owner to provide / arrange internment arrangements.
- 6. Person in charge of Dickersonville Cemetery shall be Director of Parks or designee named by said Director. Person in charge shall be responsible for locating grass site as plot is sold to the family of deceased.

The following specific ground rules also apply:

- 1. Plot owners are prohibited from allowing interments to be made in their plots from compensation.
- 2. The full purchase price must be paid to the Town before a deed is transmitted.
- 3. The Town of Lewiston reserves the right to remove all flowers, wreaths, or other decorations from plots as soon as they become unsightly.
- 4. The Town of Lewiston reserves the right to remove, after due notice to the owner, any monument, marker or effigy which, in their opinion, is unsightly or dangerous.
- 5. The Town of Lewiston reserves the right to restrict the planting of shrubs and trees and to remove any shrubs or trees deemed to be dangerous to the public.
- No vaults or mausoleums shall be built.
- 7. Placing of glass blocks or vases, as receptacles for flowers or plants, is prohibited.

- 8. The bases of all monuments shall be finished true and level so as to fit foundations without wedging or sprawling.
- 9. No monument shall be allowed to be delivered in the Cemetery, until the foundation is installed and ready to receive the monument. The monument can then be immediately installed.
- 10. Heavy trucking or vehicular traffic shall be refused entrance where, in the opinion of the Parks and Recreation Director, in which injury or damage to ground or roadways may result.
- 11. All persons shall be allowed entrance to the cemetery during daylight hours.
- 12. All monuments or markers shall be erected of marble, granite or bronze.
- 13. A disinterment shall be allowed upon application to the Town Clerk.
- 14. All plot owners are required to notify the Town Clerk of any change of address.
- 15. All notices required to be sent by the Town, shall be sent to the last recorded address and such notice shall be deemed adequate.
- 16. No internment shall take place if; in the combined opinion of person in charge and funeral director, weather conditions prohibit safe access to grave site. In such cases, internment shall be delayed until conditions permit safe access, and temporary holding of remains shall be arranged between family of deceased and funeral director.
- 17. Each internment must be a rough or concrete box, in addition to a casket.
- 18. In the case of cremation of the deceased, or in the case of an infant death, internment in one grave with previously interred cremated remains, or in a single grave site intended for later internment, is permissible.
- 19. It is the intent of the Town Board to preserve the rural character of the Dickersonville Cemetery. These Rules and Regulations may be amended by Resolution of the Town Board, from time to time, if deemed necessary or desirable.
